
## What is Medicaid?

## Am I eligible?

Eligibility depends on what state you live in. Moving to another state also changes your eligibility; make sure to check your new state's requirements.



## What kind of Medicaid can I get?

There are three types of Medicaid: long-term care Medicaid, community Medicaid and waiver programs are all options for those who qualify. Your health and financial situations dictate which programs are relevant to you.



## What are some things Medicaid covers?

Medicaid can cover costs for care such as inpatient and outpatient hospital visits, in-home care, transportation, family planning, specialized care and more.



## How long will it take me or a loved one to apply?
